

Mouse in the wind

MATERIALS

- Orange and white cardstock
- Penny Black Descent! rubberstamp (3210J)
- Do Crafts Happy Birthday Handwriting stamp (49508)
- ColorBox pigment inkpad
- BoBunny Yummy collection Mini Dots, Sweet Stripes and Sugar Slices patterned paper
- BoBunny ribbon
- Pink ribbon
- Double-sided tape
- 2mm foam pads
- Colouring pencils
- Glue

TO CREATE

1 Cut a 12.5x18cm piece of orange cardstock and fold to create a card blank.

2 Stamp the mouse image onto a 6.8x8.5cm piece of white cardstock and colour using colouring pencils.

3 Tie the pink ribbon into a bow and attach to the umbrella with glue. Stick pieces of



double-sided tape on the back of the ribbon and curl it around before you affix, to look as if the ribbon is blowing in the wind.

4 Cut a 6x8cm piece of Mini Dots paper, taking care to trim it so that the dots will make a frame around the stamped image. Cut a 6x9cm piece of Sweet Stripes paper.

5 Stick the Mini Dots paper at the top of your card, leaving about 0.5cm of an edge around it. Adhere the Sweet Stripes paper at the bottom and use blue ribbon to separate the two.

6 Stamp your sentiment onto a piece of white card and matt with a piece of Sugar Slices paper. Use glue to attach your image to the card and foam pads to attach the greeting.

TO CREATE

1 Cut a 15x30cm piece of orange cardstock and fold to create a card blank.

2 Cut out seven squares measuring 4x4cm – two

from Mini Dots paper; two from Sweet Stripes paper and three from Ribbon Stripes paper.

3 Stick the squares onto your card, leaving two empty spaces in the bottom-right for

your greeting. The squares should be about 0.5cm from the edges of the card and leave around 0.5cm between them.

4 Trim an 8.5x4cm piece of Flowers paper and stamp

MATERIALS

- Orange cardstock
- BoBunny Yummy collection Mini Dots, Sweet Stripes, Flowers and Ribbon Stripes patterned paper
- Penny Black 'Thank you' stamp (3678F)
- BoBunny ribbon
- Assorted ribbon

Expert tip

Stop ribbons from fraying at the ends, by dabbing your finger in some glue and rubbing the glue along the ribbon edge – it works wonders!

5 Tie seven different ribbons into bows and stick one onto each of the seven squares.
