



## Queen of glamour

### MATERIALS:

- Imagination Project Morningside Heights patterned paper
- Purple and white card
- Raffia
- Eyelets
- Daisy chain ribbon
- Penny Black Light the Night, Birthday Girl and Glamour stamps
- Watercolour pencils
- Black inkpad
- Diamantés

### TO CREATE:

- 1 Cover half of your card with patterned paper and attach a narrow strip of card over the central join. Attach ribbon down the strip.
- 2 Stamp the Light the Night image onto white card and colour using watercolour pencils. Attach diamantés as detail on the bracelets.
- 3 Layer the white card onto purple cardstock leaving a 3mm border, and attach to your card.
- 4 Cut two tags from purple card and stamp using the Birthday Girl and Glamour stamps.
- 5 Set eyelets into the tops of each tag, and tie through some raffia before affixing to the card.

## Flutterby wishes

### MATERIALS:

- White hammered cardstock
- Papermania butterfly die-cuts
- Papermania Citrus Colossal Paper Pack
- Gold Liquid Pearls
- 3D lacquer
- Iridescent glitter
- Papermania embossed butterfly
- Scissors
- Glue gun
- Small strip of acetate
- Double-sided tape
- Selection of flowers
- Small piece of ribbon
- Gem brad
- Embossing tool
- Ruler

### TO CREATE:

- 1 Trim down the cardstock to measure 15.5x27cm. This will make a C6 card when folded.
- 2 Score and fold along the lines as shown in the diagram.

- 3 Make a decorative edge using the embossing tool. Trim to shape.
- 4 Cut a choice of paper to fit into the back of the card, and also make two strips to go down the sides of the front sections, following the shape of the embossing.
- 5 Cut a small thin strip of acetate to measure 0.5x12cm. Attach 3cm of the acetate to the back of the patterned paper, leaving the remainder to hang at the front. Attach both to the base card as shown.
- 6 Create the hanging butterfly by placing the end of the acetate between the butterfly and a piece of paper as shown. Trim the paper around the butterfly design.
- 7 Fix the layers of the central flower and two short lengths of ribbon together with a brad. Using the glue gun, attach the flower embellishment to the centre of the card.
- 8 Attach three butterflies to each side panel at the front of the card.
- 9 Use the Liquid Pearls to add dots to the ribbon and trails behind the butterflies. Coat the butterfly with lacquer, sprinkle on the glitter and allow to dry.
